Highlights of 2019-2020....

School Closure

Remote Learning...Social distancing...Covid-19...Zoom...these terms have become all too familiar as a result of the 2020 Pandemic. Governor DeWine officially closed school buildings at the end of the school day on Monday, March 16 for three weeks to help stop the spread of Covid-19 and later mandated the closure through the end of the school year. During this time, faculty prepared "home-learning" packets for students to continue learning at home. The school staff is currently working on a formal Remote Learning plan to be implemented if a school closure would be enforced again, and preparing the school for the beginning of next year with social distancing procedures. Our goal is to be able to provide more online virtual learning if it should become necessary.

We are extremely grateful to our parents who guided their children through the home-learning packets while working through all the hardships that resulted in the economic shutdown.

Accreditation

Over the past two years the school staff has been working on our School Improvement Plan, which was submitted to the Ohio Catholic School Accrediting Association for re-accreditation this past March. We are pleased to report that our plan was granted Full Accreditation. Implementation of our goals will begin in fall 2021. Our School Improvement Plan consists of the following two goals:

Catholic Identity Goal: Students will increase their knowledge of the Corporal Works of Mercy and take action through service learning.

Student Performance Goal: Students will increase problem-solving skills by applying goal setting and self-monitoring strategies to become self-directed leaders of their educational experience.
