

## **NOTIFICATIONS OF ASBESTOS RE-INSPECTIONS**

In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) published in 40 CFR Part 763, St. Benedict School completed required asbestos inspections on our buildings in August of 2019. The original inspection findings are included in a recently completed management plan currently on file in the principal's office and the Designated Person's Office at the Diocese of Steubenville.

The EPA requires that Local Education Agencies perform re-inspections of these facilities every three years. St. Benedict School will conduct six-month surveillance inspections with in-house staff and conduct three-year re-inspections beginning in August of 2022 utilizing an independent asbestos consultant as required by AHERA.

An operations and maintenance plan is in place as is an asbestos awareness training program for all custodial and maintenance personnel.
