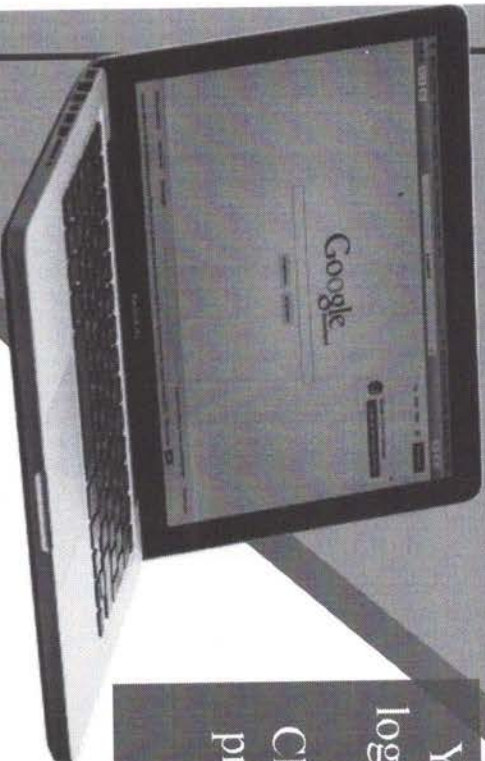
What is Google Classroom?

parents!



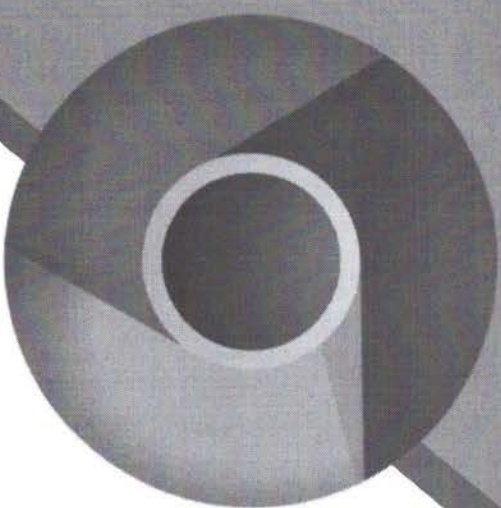
Getting Started

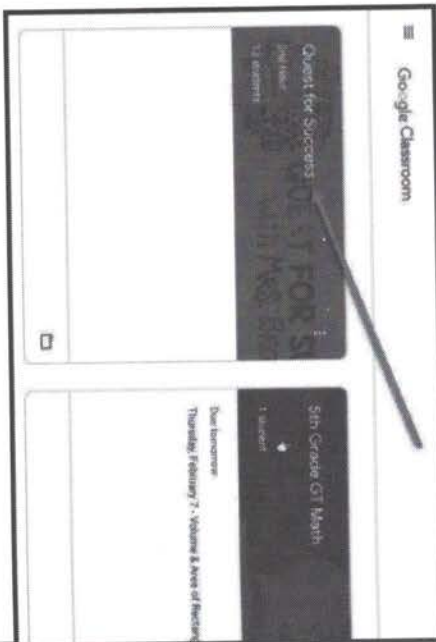
